Busuanga Island is the largest island in the Calamian Group in the province of Palawan in the Philippines. Busuanga Island is, in fact, the second largest island in the province after Palawan island itself. The island is located halfway between the islands of Mindoro and Palawan with the South China Sea located to the west and the Sulu Sea to the southeast. South of the island are the two other major islands of the Calamian Group: Culion Island and Coron Island.

Set in the heart of Coron Town, Palawan, **The Funny Lion** is a contemporary boutique resort for traveller exploring one of the most spectacular island destinations in the Philippines. Only 30-min from Busuanga Airport, The Funny Lion looks out onto a tranquil cove with virgin mangroves and kayak trails, and features modern amenities, stunning sunset views, and a distinct rustic-chic charm.

The idyllic islands of Coron are located in one of the most pristine natural wonders, with thousands of small undiscovered islands and islets that mark Coron harbor and Coron bay.

***Lake Kayangan** is one of Coron's primary attractions, often times declared to be the cleanest lake in the Philippines. Accessible by a steep 10-minute climb, the crystal-clear waters of Lake Kayangan are nestled into the mountain walls; underwater is like a moonscape. There's a little wooden walkway and platform to stash your things if you go for a swim.*



***Barracuda Lake**, Located on the north-shore of the fascinating Coron-Island (only 20 min boat ride from Coron Town) is one of the most unusual, amazing and wired dive-sites of the Philippines for its unique layers of fresh, salt and brackish water and dramatic temperature shifts, which can reach as high as 38°C. It's accessible by a short but tricky 25m climb over a jagged rocky wall (good sandals are recommended) that ends directly in the water.*



1500H After the island hopping, participants will be transferred to Coron Town for **Maquinit Hotsprings**

***Maquinit Hots Springs** is located in the hillside part of Coron, about 25 minutes from the town center. Guests will be enchanted by a pool filled with salt water coming from the bottom of the nearby mountain, it is said to come from an underground volcano and the water's temperature ranges from 38-40 degree Celsius.*
